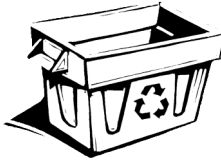


DOING SOME SPRING CLEANING?

VILLAGE BULKY ITEM COLLECTION

The Village will have a bulky item drop off Friday, May 11th from noon-6:00 p.m., and Saturday, May 12th from 8:00 a.m.-noon.

This collection is for items that are too big to fit into your trash carts. It will take place across from the village shop at 420 Wheeler Avenue. This event is for village residents only, so please bring proof of residency with you. **Sorry, we will not be able to accept items from businesses or televisions.**



METAL RECYCLING DAY

A metal recycling drive will be held at Ozaukee Middle School on Saturday, May 12th from 8:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. Acceptable donations include, but are not limited to: aluminum, appliances, bicycles, car batteries, Christmas lights, computer monitors (maximum of 2 per vehicle), dehumidifiers, electrical cords, laptop computers, lamps, lawnmowers or snow blowers (please remove any oil or gas), microwaves, printers, pots and pans, refrigerators, swing sets, tools, water heaters, workout equipment and much more! **Televisions, plastic and cardboard recyclables are not accepted.**

FREDONIA AREA RUMMAGE SALE

The Fredonia Area Rummage Sale will be Saturday, May 19th from 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. If you wish to participate by completing a registration form, your sale will be included in the handout that will be distributed to rummage sale enthusiasts via local businesses and at the Fredonia Government Center.

The cost to register is \$5.00, which will be used to offset advertising costs. BRANCH CHIPPING

Weather permitting, curbside branch chipping will begin Monday, April 9th in the Village of Fredonia. When placing branches curbside for pickup, please put cut ends toward the curb. Branches should be laying next to each other, not crisscrossing. Please keep branches to 10 feet or less in length. **The maximum diameter accepted is 6", and no root balls will be accepted.** Failure to comply with these rules may result in branches not being picked up.

To arrange for this service, please call Village Hall at (262) 692-9125 prior to 7:00 a.m. Monday. Every effort is made to pick up branches when they are called in; however, if there are too many locations, your branches will be picked up the following Monday. Wood chips will be available to the public as supply permits. **Branches are not to be dropped off at the Wastewater Treatment yard waste site.**

COMPOST

The Village has screened compost available for village residents. The compost is located at the rear of the yard waste drop off site at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Leaves and yard debris may be put on the compost pile at the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

When dropping off material at the yard waste site, please be sure to remove animal waste, plastic, wood, paper, metal, litter and other non-compostable materials. If you use plastic bags to transport your yard waste, please remember to take your bags with you when you leave. **Open burning of grass and leaves is prohibited in the Village of Fredonia.**

TORNADO SEASON

The week of April 9-13 is Wisconsin's Tornado and Severe Weather Awareness Week. The National Weather Service and Wisconsin Emergency Management have teamed up to sponsor statewide tornado drills on Thursday, April 12th. A test tornado watch will be issued at 1:00 p.m. on April 12th for the entire state of Wisconsin. At 1:45 p.m., a test tornado warning will be issued statewide. At 6:45 p.m., a second test tornado warning will be issued. These test drills are implemented to give families and businesses a chance to practice their emergency severe weather plans. If actual severe storms are expected in the state on April 12th, the drills will be postponed until Friday, April 13th. If severe storms are expected Friday, the drills will be cancelled.

If a tornado warning is issued for Fredonia, the siren will be activated for three minutes. Please take shelter immediately, as this warning means that a tornado sighting has been confirmed. The siren will be tested on the second Tuesday of the month from March to November at 7:00 p.m.

REMINDER FROM THE WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT

Please be mindful of what is being flushed down your toilets. Flushing anything that is not supposed to be flushed can lead to clogs not only in your home's plumbing, but also in the Village's sewer system. Items backed up in the sewer system can cause basement backups or overflows in your home, as well as costly pump station repairs that all customers pay for.

Common items that should not be flushed include:

Diapers

Wet wipes (baby wipes, facial wipes)

Feminine hygiene products

Condoms

Grease

Facial Tissue

Cotton Swabs

POLICE DEPARTMENT REMINDERS

- **Non-Emergency Number:** If you need to contact the police department for any non-emergency situation, call the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Department at (262) 284-7172. They will dispatch an officer to you. **Always call 911 in an emergency.**
- **Dog Owners:** Please be considerate and quiet your barking dog, as your neighbors may have their windows open. Also, when walking your dog make sure it is always on a leash, and clean up after it.
- **Dog Licenses** are required per Wisconsin Statute 174.05 for any dog 5 months of age and older. The cost is \$10. If the dog is spayed or neutered, the cost is \$5. There is a \$5 late fee charged if the license is obtained after March 31st. Information required includes dog's name, breed, color, sex and evidence of rabies vaccination. Licenses are available at Village Hall.
- **Curfew:** Persons under the age of 16 are not allowed out after 11:00 p.m. unless accompanied by a parent or guardian, except when attending a school function or returning home from their place of employment.
- **Bicyclists:** Bicycle riders must obey the same traffic rules as automobiles. For safety, bicycles should be ridden single file on the far right side of the road. Helmet use is encouraged.
- **Basketball Hoops** are not to be placed in the roadway. Not only is this a traffic hazard, but it encourages children to play in the road which is dangerous.
- **Village Parks** close at 9:00 p.m. unless otherwise noted. People in the parks after hours are subject to a fine.
- **Motorized Scooters** are not legal on streets unless the operator is a licensed driver.
- **Village Code prohibits** discharging of firearms, including B.B. guns and paintball guns, or explosives, including firearms, within Village limits.
