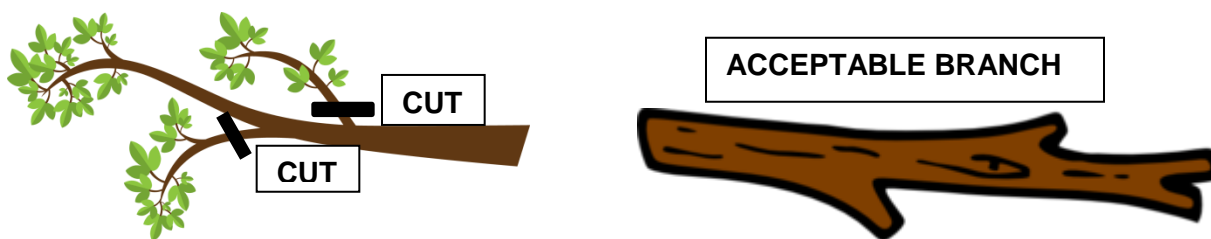


VILLAGE OF FREDONIA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

BRUSH – LEAVES – YARD WASTE

- Curbside branch collection is offered to residents every Monday in the Village of Fredonia (weather permitting). When placing branches curbside for pickup, please place the cut ends toward the curb. Branches should be lying next to each other, not crisscrossing. The maximum diameter accepted is 6". Branches should be less than 10 feet in length. Secondary branches more than 2 feet in length extending off of the main branch must be removed. Chipping including cleanup that takes more than 20 minutes at one residence or place of business in a single stop will be charged at a rate of \$1.00/minute for every minute over 20 minutes. At the discretion of the Director of Public Works, the Village may choose to waive this fee. Failure to comply with these rules may result in branches not being picked up. You will need to call the village office at (262) 692-9125 prior to 7 a.m. Monday morning to arrange for this service. **Branches are not to be dropped off at the Wastewater Treatment Plant yard waste site.** Wood chips are available to the public as supply permits.



- Leaves and yard debris may be put on the compost pile at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. If you use plastic bags to transport your waste, please remember to take your bags with you.
- Open burning of grass and leaves is prohibited in the Village of Fredonia.
- In fall, the Village of Fredonia offers curbside collection of leaves on Tuesdays. Actual dates will be posted in the News Flash section of our website. Please make sure to keep raked leaves away from the catch basins. Village ordinance allows leaves to be raked to the curb up to 72 hours before a scheduled curbside pickup.
