### CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION



The Village of Fredonia will have curbside collection of leaves with pick-up west of the railroad tracks scheduled for Tuesday, October 12th and 26th and November 9th.

Pick-up of leaves east of the railroad tracks will be on Tuesday, October 19th and November 2nd and 16th. Be sure to keep leaves away from the catch basins. Village ordinance allows leaves to be raked to the curb up to 72 hours before a scheduled curbside pick-up.

Weather permitting - curbside branch chipping will continue on Mondays. To be included on the weekly curbside branch chipping list you need to call Village Hall at 692-9125 prior to the Monday you want the chipping done.

### HYDRANT FLUSHING

The Fredonia Water Utility will be flushing hydrants in the village during the weeks of October 18th and October 25th. Due to this, some discoloration of water and low pressure may occur. The water is completely safe during all stages of the flushing program; however, please check the water for discoloration prior to washing any clothes on these dates.



### THEFT PREVENTION TIPS FROM OUR POLICE DEPARTMENT

In today's society, theft is the most commonly committed crime. Over half of thefts can be prevented if you follow three simple precautions:

- ◆ Eliminate the opportunity for the thief to steal your property.
- ◆ Properly secure your personal property.
- ◆ Properly mark your valuables for identification.

Don't leave your valuables lying around in plain sight (cash, jewelry, car keys, gold, credit cards etc.). These items could be easily picked up and taken. Secure them in locked compartments or drawers. Also, when you are in public, keep your eyes on your valuables at all times. And ALWAYS lock your doors when you leave your house, and vehicle—even if it's for just a few minutes. Please remember to protect and restrict your house/business/apartment and other keys that would give access to your valuables. ## FRIENDLY REMINDER -

Village ordinance prohibits the depositing of grass into public streets at any time. Please be courteous and do not blow grass clippings or mow directly into the street.

## WINTER ORDINANCE REMINDERS

- ◆ Parking is not allowed on village streets between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from December 1st to April 1st. Any vehicle ticketed for winter parking restrictions and not removed will be towed away at the owner's expense.
- ◆ Snow is to be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours after a snowfall.
- ◆ Snow is not to be shoveled or blown into the street.
- ◆ Discharge from sump pumps may not be directed onto the street from November 1st to May 1st.
- ◆ When shoveling out mailboxes, be sure to shovel a car-length pathway in front of your mailbox to guarantee mail delivery.

## OZAUKEE CO. FLU CLINIC

Ozaukee County Health Department will be offering vaccines at the Waubeka Fire Department, W4114 River Road on Saturday, October 9th from 12:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. Flu shots are \$28, pneumonia shots are \$40, and tetanus shots are \$10. Medicare Part B will cover the cost of the flu and pneumonia vaccines. ## Could you use more food—at no cost to you?

If you are:

- ◆ 60 years of age or older (55 or older for Native Americans)
- ◆ Monthly household income less than \$1,174 for a household of one—or—\$1,579 for household of two.

Then you are eligible for a **STOCKBOX** each month containing cheese, canned fruit and vegetables, juice, cereal, peanut butter, meat, rice and dried milk. This is provided by the Commodity Supplement Food Program of the USDA. Local distribution provided by the Hunger Task Force in Milwaukee and Full Shelf Food Pantry in West Bend. You can sign up and receive your STOCKBOX at Fredonia Village Hall, 242 Fredonia Ave on Tuesday, October 19th from 11am—12:00 p.m. Call 262-692-2644 if you have any questions or have transportation issues and need your STOCKBOX delivered.

## TO REPORT A STREET LIGHT OUTAGE

Since it is fall, and our daylight hours are becoming shorter, it may be more noticeable that a street light is out in your neighborhood. If you see a burned out street light, you may call WE Energies at 1-800-242-9137, or you can email them at [www.weenergies.com](http://www.weenergies.com). You can click on "contact us", and then "residential customer service". Please try to be as specific as possible when advising them of the pole location. You can also call the Village Hall at 692-9125, and we will let WE Energies know.

## HOLIDAY GARBAGE PICK-UP SCHEDULE & REMINDERS

- ◆ The week of Thanksgiving garbage and recycling pick-up will be on Friday, November 26th.
- ◆ Since Christmas and New Year's fall on weekends this year, there will be no deviations to the scheduled pick ups.
- ◆ Village Code prohibits garbage to be placed curbside more than **24** hours prior to pick-up.
- ◆ The Postmaster has requested that you avoid setting your garbage in front of your mailbox in order to assure mail delivery.
- ◆ Scavenging of refuse placed curbside for collection without the owners permission is prohibited.
- ◆ If you are disposing of ash, be sure to set it out in its own container. If the driver detects **ANY** warmth to the material, it will be left behind.
- ◆ It is against the law for residents to dispose of sharps (needles, syringes and lancets) in their regular garbage. Ask your local doctor, clinic, or pharmacy if they are a registered sharps collector. You can also contact the DNR at 608-266-2111, the American Diabetes Association at 888-342-2382 or the UW Extension at 608-257-3665 for locations of registered sharps collection stations.
