### WARM WEATHER REMINDERS:

- **Dog Owners** - Please be considerate and quiet your barking dog as your neighbors may have their windows open. Also, when you walk your dog, be sure it is on a leash and clean up after it.   
**Violators will be cited.**
- **Growing Bushes** - Keep them well trimmed around the water meters to help the village crew get an easier view when reading meters.
- **Curfew** - Persons under the age of 16 are not allowed out after 11:00 p.m. unless accompanied by a parent or guardian, except when attending a school function or returning home from their place of employment.
- **Bicyclists** - Bicycle riders must obey the same traffic rules as automobiles. For  safety, bicycles should be ridden single file on the far right side of the road. Bicycle helmet use is encouraged.
- **Yard Clean-Up** - Leaves and yard debris may be put on the compost pile at the Waste-Water Treatment Plant. If you use plastic bags to transport your yard waste, be sure to take the bags along with you. Open burning of grass and leaves is prohibited in the village.

### HOLIDAY GARBAGE PICK-UP SCHEDULE



Because Memorial Day is on a Monday, garbage and recycling will be picked up on Friday of that week. This year the 4th of July falls on a Tuesday, therefore garbage and recycling pick-up for that week will be on Friday, July 7th.

### CURBSIDE BRANCH COLLECTION

Curbside branch collection is offered to residents every Monday in the Village of Fredonia. When placing branches curbside for pick-up, please put cut ends toward the curb. Branches should be laying next to each other; not criss-crossing. The maximum diameter accepted is 6". Failure to comply with these rules may result in branches not being picked up. You will need to call the village shop at 692-9179 or the village hall at 692-9125 to arrange for this service. Branch drop-off is no longer allowed at the WWTP site. However, wood chips are available to the public as supply permits.

### NEW RECYCLING PROGRAM

The Village of Fredonia has switched its recycling program to the Wisconsin DNR's newly approved "Single Stream" Recycling Program. Now you can put **ALL** your recyclable items together in the **BLUE** recycling bag. All of your glass, plastic bottles, aluminum cans, tin cans, paper, junk mail, magazines and small broken down cardboard can be mixed together in a single blue recycling bag. Newspapers no longer need to be bundled and tied. You may place them in the blue recycling bag along with all your other recyclable items. All trash must still be kept separate and placed in a **CLEAR** bag. Do not mix trash and recycling items together in the same bag. Garbage and recyclables must be placed curbside by 7:00 a.m. on Thursdays, but not more than 24 hours before pick up.

## DOG LICENSES REQUIRED



Village Code requires that dogs need to be vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian within 30 days after the dog reaches 4 months of age. Any dog **5 months of age and older is required to be licensed** in the Village of Fredonia. The cost is \$10.00. If the animal is spayed or neutered the cost is \$5.00. If you did not obtain a license prior to April 1st, a \$5.00 late fee will be charged in addition to the required license fee. Information required includes the dog's name, color, breed, sex, and evidence and date of rabies vaccination. To obtain a license please bring this information to the village hall during regular business hours. If you have a dog that is recently deceased, please notify us so that we can update our records.

## GARDEN HOTLINE

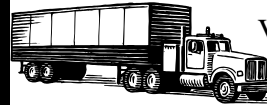

## OUTDOOR FURNACES PROHIBITED

Per Village Code, it is illegal to construct, install, operate, locate or use an outdoor furnace which is marketed for primary or supplemental heating of, or is used to provide heat to any building or structure or equipment within the Village of Fredonia.

## TRUCK PARKING REGULATED



Village Ordinance prohibits vehicles having a gross weight of more than 15,000 pounds to park on the street in any residentially zoned district. The vehicles are allowed to temporarily park for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading or in receiving or discharging passengers or goods and while the vehicle is attended by a licensed operator so that it may promptly be moved in case of an emergency or to avoid obstruction of traffic. It is also illegal to park the trailer of any commercial or business vehicle on any street within the Village of Fredonia.

## FREBEKA 5 MILE RUN



The **Frebeka 5 Walk/Run** will be held on Sunday, June 25th. There will be a 5 mile run, a 2 mile run, a 2 mile walk, and a kids run. ## BUILDING PERMITS



Building permits are required for any new construction, any structural change, or any projects that exceed \$500 in value. Therefore, permits are needed for decks, sheds, most remodeling projects, installation of a bay or bow window and basement fix-ups. Some permits need to be reviewed by the Architectural Control Board so allow plenty of time to obtain your permit. A permit is **NOT** needed for re-siding or re-roofing.

## SEWER JETTING
