2011 TAXES

Taxes for 2011 may be paid at the Fredonia Village Hall, 242 Fredonia Avenue, Fredonia, Wisconsin, during normal business hours. The Village Hall is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 A.M. until Noon and from 1:00 P.M. until 4:30 P.M. Checks for payment of taxes should be in the correct amount. **If an overpayment occurs, the refund will be made by check within fifteen business days to the property owner.**

The Village Hall will close at noon on December 23, 2011 and will be closed all day December 26, 2011.



If a receipt is desired, a self-addressed, stamped envelope must accompany your payment.

Real Estate taxes may also be paid at Port Washington State Bank in Fredonia. Taxes will be accepted **inside the bank lobby only.** The lobby is open Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., Friday from 9:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m., and Saturday from 9:00 a.m. until Noon. Please bring your tax bill with you. Any tax refund check will be issued immediately by the bank.

CHRISTMAS TREE DISPOSAL

The village crew will chip discarded Christmas trees each Monday in January. Please place your tree curbside before 7:00 a.m. Wreaths are disposed of by placing with your regular garbage.

DOG LICENSES

When mailing in your taxes, please be sure to include a separate payment for dog licenses. Dog licenses may only be obtained at the Fredonia Village Hall

•**Dog Licenses** are required for any dog five months of age and older. The cost is \$10. If the dog is spayed or neutered the cost is \$5, with an additional \$5 late fee charged after April 1st. Information required includes the dog's name, color, breed, sex, and evidence and date of rabies vaccination.

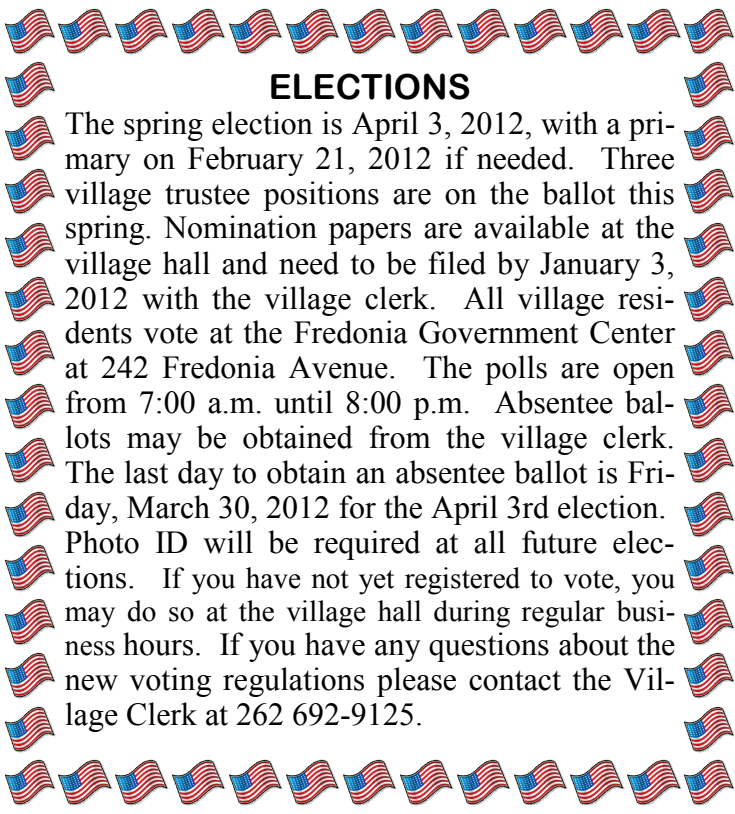
•**Dog Owners** - Please be considerate and quiet your barking dogs. Also, when you walk your dog, be sure it is on a leash and **clean up after it.**

WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS

- * Parking is not allowed on village streets between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from December 1st to April 1st. Any vehicles ticketed for winter parking restrictions and not removed within 24 hours will be towed away at owner's expense.
- * Snow is to be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours after a snowfall.
- * Snow is not to be shoveled or blown into the street.
- * Discharge from sump pumps may not be directed onto the street from November 1st to May 1st.
- * When shoveling out mailboxes, be sure to shovel a car length pathway in front of your mailbox to guarantee mail delivery.
- * Please shovel out your fire hydrant.

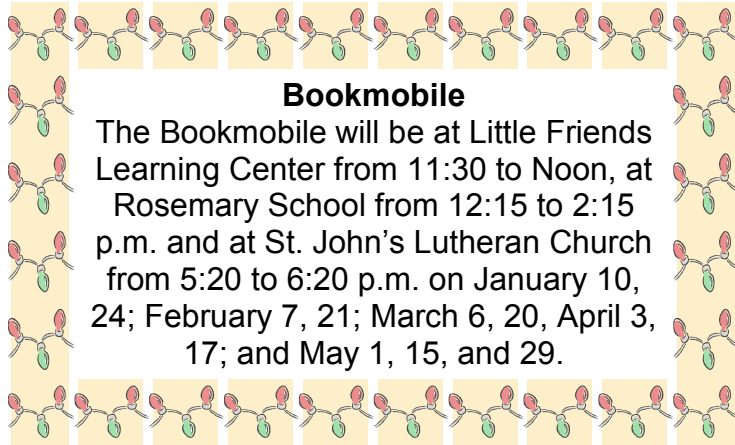


ELECTIONS

The spring election is April 3, 2012, with a primary on February 21, 2012 if needed. Three village trustee positions are on the ballot this spring. Nomination papers are available at the village hall and need to be filed by January 3, 2012 with the village clerk. All village residents vote at the Fredonia Government Center at 242 Fredonia Avenue. The polls are open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. Absentee ballots may be obtained from the village clerk. The last day to obtain an absentee ballot is Friday, March 30, 2012 for the April 3rd election. Photo ID will be required at all future elections. If you have not yet registered to vote, you may do so at the village hall during regular business hours. VILLAGE MEETINGS

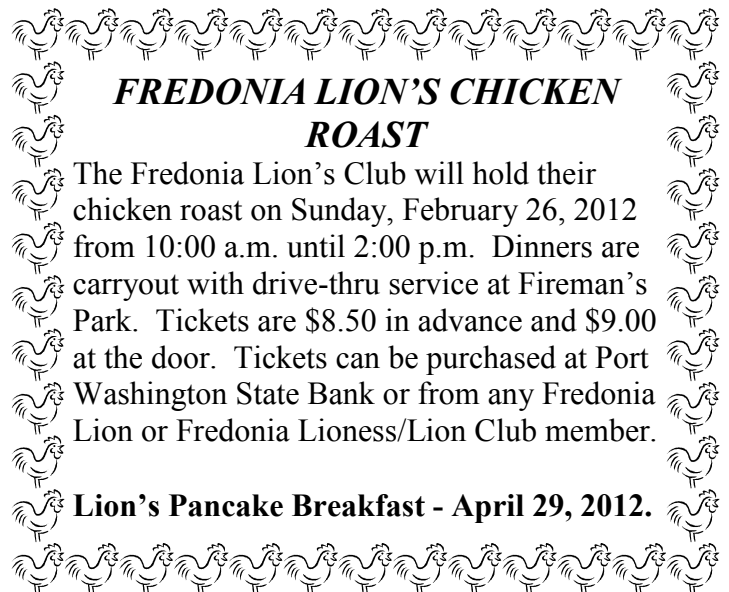
