HOLIDAY GARBAGE PICK-UP SCHEDULE

The schedule for Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Years Day for garbage and recycling pick-up will be on **Friday** of each of those weeks. Village Code prohibits garbage to be placed curbside more than **24** hours prior to pick-up. Also, the Postmaster has requested that you avoid setting your garbage in front of your mailbox in order to assure mail delivery.

VILLAGE ELECTIONS

Any village resident interested in running for the position of village trustee can pick up nomination papers at the Village Hall beginning December 3, 2007. Papers must be returned by the first Tuesday in January for the spring election to be held in April. Three Village Trustee positions will be voted on for a two-year term. If you have any questions please call the village hall.

WINTER ORDINANCE REMINDERS

- ◆ Parking is not allowed on village streets between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from December 1st to April 1st. Any vehicle ticketed for winter parking restrictions and not removed will be towed away at the owner's expense.
- ◆ Snow is to be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours after a snowfall.
- ◆ Snow is not to be shoveled or blown into the street.
- ◆ Discharge from sump pumps may not be directed onto the street from November 1st to May 1st.
- ◆ When shoveling out mailboxes, be sure to shovel a car-length pathway in front of your mailbox to guarantee mail delivery.

POLICE DEPARTMENT REMINDERS

- **Basketball hoops** are not to be placed in the roadway. When placed in the roadway they are not only a traffic hazard but it also encourages children to play in the road which is dangerous.
- **Motorists** are reminded to drive cautiously in school zones during the morning and afternoon hours when there is increased vehicle and pedestrian traffic. Also, watch for school busses and obey their stop signals when they are picking up and dropping kids off at bus stops. Speed and inattention are the two biggest causes of accidents. Please drive at the speed limit, pay attention, and watch for children.
- Village Code **prohibits** hunting, discharging of firearms - including B.B. guns and paintball guns, or explosives - including fireworks, within the Village of Fredonia.
- **Motorized scooters or mopeds** are not legal on streets unless the operator is a licensed driver.
- **Village Parks** close at 9:00 p.m. unless otherwise noted. People in the parks after hours are subject to a \$172.00 fine.
- The Police Department has recovered numerous bikes in the past year. If your bike was lost or stolen please contact the Police Department at 692-9125 to check if they have it stored in their property inventory. To claim the bike you will need to provide the make, model, color and size.

CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION



The Village of Fredonia will have curbside collection of leaves with pick-up west of the railroad tracks scheduled for October 16th and 30th and November 13th. Pick-up of leaves east of the railroad tracks will be on Tuesday, October 23rd and November 6th and 20th. Be sure to keep leaves away from the catch basins. Village ordinance allows leaves to be raked to the curb up to 72 hours before a scheduled curbside pick-up.

Weather permitting - curbside branch chipping will continue on Mondays. To be included on the weekly curbside brush chipping list you must call the village hall at 692-9125 or the shop at 692-9179 prior to the Monday you want the chipping done.

HYDRANT FLUSHING

The Fredonia Water Utility will be flushing hydrants in the village during the weeks of October 22nd and October 29th. Due to this, some discoloration of water and low pressure may occur. The water is completely safe during all stages of the flushing program; however, please check the water for discoloration prior to washing any clothes on these dates.




CAT RESTRICTIONS IN VILLAGE

It is unlawful for a person to allow their cat to run at large off of the owner's property. The owner of any animal, whether licensed or unlicensed, shall keep the animal tied or enclosed in a proper enclosure so as not to allow said animal to interfere with the passing public or neighbors.

OZAUKEE CO. FLU CLINIC

 Ozaukee County Health Department will be offering vaccines at the Waubeka Fire Department, W4114 River Street on Sunday, October 7th from 11:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Flu shots are \$23, pneumonia shots are \$30, and tetanus shots are \$5. Medicare Part B will cover the cost of the flu and pneumonia vaccines. No appointment is necessary. Please wear a garment that will allow the nurse easy access to the upper arm area where you will receive the injection. Remember to update your child's KIDS CARE ID photo, or have it done that day for the first time. Feel free to come and tour the station and talk to a member about becoming a Firefighter, EMT or Ambulance Driver.

If the Fire Department is notified, they will respond to your residence and make an attempt to help. If they don't have the equipment, they will try to help you find someone who can assist you.
